Treasurers Report: \$7,378.89 as of 10/31/19

Currently have 46 members, PayPal is up and running and only one member has utilized it so far.

Neighborhood Signage Replacement:

- 1. Deyerle Rd. near Brandon Ave (replacement)**
- 2. Mud Lick near Brandon Ave. (replacement)**
- 3. Circle Dr./Grandin Rd. intersection (replacement)**
- 4. Crestmoor Dr. near Lewis Gale (replacement)**
- 5. Grandin Rd near 419 (new location-across from Famous Anthony's (pending agreement from apartment or landowner)**
- 6. 6. Grandin Rd/Mud Lick Rd island (new location, checking with city on visibility)**

Mike Dame is in the process of completing the City of Roanoke's 2020-21 Neighborhood Development Grant application which is due January 17, 2020. Need to gather estimates from three signage vendors, pricing will determine how many signs can be replaced this year. This will likely be a 2-3 year project.

A suggestion was made to contact Bill St. Pierre in Floyd as he has a state of the art printing business. Business donations were also suggested such as One Earth Landscaping. Quotes needed by January 1, 2020. The new GDNA logo will be on the signs. We can apply for up to \$3,750.00 for the neighborhood grant; the last time GDNA applied was 2012.

Neighborhood Plan 2040

Discussed ideas to explore as we partner with the City to develop our 2040 neighborhood plan. The following items were discussed;

- 1. Commercial encroachment**
- 2. Traffic calming**
- 3. Pedestrian amenities (sidewalks along Mud Lick, trails, greenway spur)**

4. Road maintenance, paving, shoulders and ditches
5. Curbs, guttering
6. Storm drainage

Police Report: Break-in at Windsor Hills United Methodist Church, theft at One Earth Landscaping of over \$60,000 in equipment. Police will continue to monitor speed in our neighborhood.
