Hybrid-Wolf Dog Deer Attack on Mudlick - Update

On Thursday June 26th, 4 aggressive hybrid-wolf dogs attacked and killed a deer in the front yard of a house on Mud Lick Road. The home owners had to fight off these dogs in order to protect their own pets from attack. Although the authorities were immediately called and responded, the dogs were ultimately returned to their owners with no charges filed.

Since that time, there has been quite the grassroots efforts to document all previous incidents, research applicable codes/laws related to not only hybrid-wolf dogs, but aggressive/violent pets in general. Since the incident, charges have been filed on the owner and include 3 charges of Running at Large and a charge for Duty of Owner. The court date is anticipated to be Tuesday, August 5. There will be additional information provided on this topic at the July 31st GDNA Meeting.

Did You Know? Roanoke City Recycling

Since 2015, the City of Roanoke has offered curbside single-stream recycling, which means all recyclable materials can be placed in the same bin. However, placing your recyclables in a plastic trash bag is a big no-no.

Here is a quick reminder of what is and is not recyclable. Hot tip: Most yogurt containers are plastics #5, so are the plastic cups that your Starbucks cold brews come in.
