## **Minutes for Board Meeting**

## April 17, 2025

A meeting of the Greater Deyerle Neighborhood Association Board was called by the president of the association, Adam Mastrangelo.

- (3) <u>Location & Time</u> Covenant Presbyterian Church Parking lot and grounds if outside & CPC Entrance, Fellowship Hall, etc. if rain. Time 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.
- (4) <u>Tasks, Organizations, Etc.</u> Lee will coordinate with CPC, Star City Compost, etc. Teresa/Adam will coordinate with Roanoke County Planners, City Police, Roanoke City Traffic, Roanoke Arts Commission, CVC, etc. Teresa will setup "SignupGenius" to track the potluck "sides" or "deserts" brought by attendees. Coolers to be brought by Janet, Adam, etc. Janet will bring sign decorations, balloons, etc. and will assist with name tags at the event.
- (5) Other Items Let attendees know to bring their own chairs for outside. Encourage attendees to RSVP online. Get group of volunteers to help setup & prep before and tear down & clean up after the event. Janet thought we needed some sort of game or activity to get everyone to mix and mingle. Should we have giveaways?
