Roanoke City Mass Zoning Changes Repealed...for now.

City Council on Monday June 17th voted to begin the process of repealing and replacing in "similar substance" the mass zoning changes that were adopted in March. Rather than fight the lawsuit filed in April, City Attorney Tim Spencer said the redo — which will involve more public hearings and another vote by the planning commission and City Council — will be more efficient than arguing the matter in court. No public hearings on the matter have been scheduled at this time.

ABoone Amends Zoning Application Again

On May 14, ABoone Real Estate amended their zoning application a 2nd time - increasing the number of townhomes from 17 to 24 (and in the initial application from 8 single family patio homes to 17 townhomes). Based on input from Medmont residents, ABoone Real Estate requested a continuance on his application until July 8, 2024 @1:30pm at the Noel C. Taylor Municipal Building, Room 450, 4th Floor, 215 Church Ave
