The police department is down 60 officers from the normal force of 260 officers. Decrease related to unsustainable salary, and national climate.

Marlene Campbell spoke to the committee about an exemption of opening a day care center in her home. She has lived in the neighborhood for nine years when there was no zoning ordinance, (new ordinance took effect several years ago). Special exemption for childcare, four cars in front of house and four cars behind the house. Total of 12 children day shift only.
